P12 Documentation

Acceptable:

- School report cards
- Doctor records
- Immunization records
- Certificate of Baptism
- Previous registration history with a sports program

Unacceptable forms of proof documentation include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Passport entry page
- Class Photo from 3rd Grade that does not individually identify each student
- Letter from player/parents verifying the date they moved to the country

Minors Documentation

One copy of all of the following:

1. Player's Passport
2. Player's Birth Certificate
3. Player's Parents' Passports
4. Player's Parents' Work Visas (if available)
5. Player's Parents' Proof of Residence (Water bill, lease agreement, etc.)
6. Player's Parents' Proof of Employment (Pay Stub, Employment Verification Letter, etc.)

Procedures/Approval/Distribution

1. US citizens, any age, who were born outside the US and have never registered with any team in another country: Code FR11

Completed Form FR11 (original and 4 copies) to team/club
Player entered in online system and placed on roster
Paperwork submitted to Assigned League Registrar (ALR) with roster for approval
ALR signature, bird stamp, and date on all FR11 forms
Original FR11 form to VYSA
Other copies of form: League Registrar, ALR file, Team, Player

2. Players, any age, who were born outside the US and entered the US before age 12: Code P12

Completed P12 form (original and 4 copies) to team/club
Two copies of documentation to team/club
Player entered in online system and placed on roster
Paperwork and documentation submitted to Assigned League Registrar (ALR) with roster for approval
ALR signature, bird stamp, and date on all P12 forms
Original form and one copy of documentation to VYSA
One copy of form and second copy of documentation for ALR file
Other copies of form: League Registrar, Team, Player

3. Non-US citizens over age 18, who have never registered with any team in another country: Code FR11

Completed Form FR11 to VYSA (mail, email, fax)
Form submitted by VYSA to appropriate soccer organization
Approval received by VYSA office
VYSA office notifies club and ALR
Player entered in online registration system and placed on roster
ALR processes registration paperwork; retains copy of approval for ALR file
Club provides copy of FR11 approval to player; retains copy for club file

4. All players, U12-U17, born outside the US, who do not qualify for 1, 2 or 3 above, and who moved to US with parent(s) after age 12 for reasons other than to play soccer: Code ITC

Completed Form ITC to VYSA (mail, email, fax)
Copies of required documents to VYSA (mail, email, fax)
Form and documents submitted by VYSA to appropriate soccer organization
Approval received by VYSA office
VYSA office notifies club and ALR
Player entered in online registration system and placed on roster
ALR processes registration paperwork; retains copy of approval for ALR file
Club provides copy of P12 approval to player; retains copy for club file

5. All other players born outside the US: Code ITC

Completed Form ITC to VYSA (mail, email, fax)
Form submitted by VYSA to appropriate soccer organization
Approval received by VYSA office
VYSA office notifies club and ALR
Player entered in online registration system and placed on roster
ALR processes registration paperwork; retains copy of approval for ALR file
Club provides copy of P12 approval to player; retains copy for club file

Online Coding

N – Player has never lived outside the US
n/a – Grandfathered players in the system with n/a prior to July 1, 2011 (no forms required)
P12 – Proof of Entry Prior to 12 (new forms required)
FR11 – First Registration (new forms required)
IW - Grandfathered player in system with waiver prior to July 1, 2011 (must show previously approved International Clearance Waiver form)
IC - Grandfathered player in system with international clearance prior to July 1, 2011 (must show proof of previous approved International Clearance)
***ITC – International Transfer Clearance
